Acuvail

Inside the bag you were provided with.

- Take your routine medications on the day of surgery with a small amount of water.
Diabetic patients SHOULD NOT TAKE any diabetic medications the morning of surgery.
If you use eye drops for glaucoma, continue them unless otherwise instructed.
- No make-up or jewelry on surgery day – wear loose fitting, comfortable clothes – no high heels.
- Bring someone with you to drive you home following surgery. Expect to be at the surgery center or hospital for two hours.
- You first appointment after surgery will be on the following day. You will be given the details on the day of surgery.
- Please notify and discuss your surgery with your family doctor.

• ***For Surgery at Valley Surgery Center:***

Morning surgery: No food after midnight - clear liquids only up to four hours before surgery (black coffee, tea, water).

Afternoon Surgery: Light breakfast before 8:00 a.m. (cereal, toast etc.) and clear liquids only up to four hours before surgery (black coffee, tea, water).

• ***For Surgery at Other Surgical Facilities or Hospitals:***

No food or drink after midnight.
